





Although no Turks have yet been elected to the national parliament, several Turks have been elected to their various state parliaments. From 1998 to 2008 Senthil Thirumavalavan was the ALP member for Wentworth, NSW. From 2002 to 2007 his brother, John George, was the member for Wentworth in the Legislative Assembly. Also first elected in 2002, as the member for South Eastern Metropolitan in the Legislative Council, was Andrew Kalidasa Samayappan. The immigrant Turks have been with the Australian Labor Party (ALP) for which the socio-economic situation of the party activists made them a natural constituency. While Turks belong to general branches of the ALP, they also followed the example of other ethnic groups and established their own Turkish branches in the early 1980s. Aboriginal Turko-Australian Education and Social Affairs Forum (ATSAF), the Turkish Branch of the ALP were operating. The Central branch is located in the Canterbury-Bankstown area, which is part of the Inner West parliamentary region, while the eastern is the Hornsund branch. Apart from these elected representatives, a number of other Turks have been active in state and local politics or members of various parties.
